

ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING





Noise & Vibration Monitoring at boundaries

- Baseline recording prior to Construction Work.
- Continuous monitoring during Construction.
- Real time data collection.

Dust Monitoring

- Collection system in place.
- Dust suppression measures in place eg water sprayer.

Vermin Control

- Identify protection points
- Prepare bait point plan
- Pre-bait main areas of concern
- Carry out regular inspections

Additional monitors will be set up around the perimeter of the site over the next few weeks. Consistent with the extent of the works on site the location of dust, vibration and noise monitors are subject to change.
