Opening of Mount Brown Entrance

Dear Resident



Welcome to Resident Connect, this edition of Connect relates to the new entrance at the new children's hospital at Mount Brown, this newly created entrance is due to open in mid-September.

As part of the grant of planning by An Bord Pleánala, it has been agreed that construction vehicles will use both the Rialto entrance on the St. James's Campus and a newly created entrance at Mount Brown. It is likely that the majority of the construction traffic will access / exit the site via Rialto as it best serves the construction work as per grant of planning / Environmental Impact Study. . There will be a wheel wash for construction vehicles located within the vicinity of the newly created entrance.


The new entrance at Mount Brown will be securely gated and located 15 metres in from the road, any construction vehicles entering the site at this location will be able to safely drive in off the road without blocking traffic and respect all users on the road. The entrance junction will form a priority junction with Mount Brown.

The new Mount Brown entrance is designed to serve:


- the construction phase of the new children's hospital
- service vehicles accessing the facilities yard within the basement of the new children's hospital and
- patient/visit cars accessing the basement car park once the new children's hospital becomes operational

When the hospital is operational, there are plans to provide a signalised pedestrian crossing on Mount Brown.
